Watchet Library:

- (i) To discuss a plan of action for the damp in the building and other maintenance issues. Cllr Irven gave the following update:
 - When the Library building was transferred back to WTC in 2019 a sum was also given by SCC towards potential building maintenance and included in our earmarked reserves. An incipient crack was known to be present in the outside wall above the entrance door running down within the mortar joints from the parapet coping stones to the doorway. It was not in need of immediate attention.
 - Currently, over the recent period damp has been noticed in the plasterwork surrounding the
 interior of the doorway, and at one point the carpet below the heating pipes was wet. In addition,
 some damp and deterioration of the plaster has been observed in the rear passageway
 accessed via the rear door.
 - Damp may be exacerbated by condensation and what heating settings are used to minimise energy consumption.

Recommendation

That we ask appropriate builder/decorator/assessors to assess and gain quotes for the work required to rectify the damp problems involving repair and redecoration. This is justified on an EH&S and assets basis.

A discussion ensued. Cllr Richards proposed that 'the recommendation is approved as presented with delegation given to the Clerk with support from Cllr Brake to action'. Seconded by Cllr Westcott. Carried.
