### Speed Watch Scheme – Brendon Road

Due to a concern from a local resident regarding the traffic speeds along Brendon Road, particularly by the entrance to the Mill site, Watchet Town Council has requested that Avon and Somerset Police install a data Capture Box (DCB) to monitor traffic speed along this section of road, to see if, in their opinion there was concern for public safety.

Whilst we are waiting for this to be taken place, we are writing to residents, to see if there is any interest in signing up to a SpeedWatch scheme through Avon & Somerset Police. Watchet Town Council will be happy to make the initial contact with Avon & Somerset Police on behalf of any interested parties who wish to be involved in a SpeedWatch Scheme, in an attempt to reduce the traffic speed in the affected area.

The SpeedWatch scheme will involve a team of local residents willing to volunteer a small amount of time each week. You would be trained and issued with speed detection equipment to monitor speeds by Avon & Somerset Police.

The data collected by members will be provided directly to Avon & Somerset Police. Vehicles observed speeding will be sent a warning letter along with advice to help change their driving behaviour.
