Following last month's meeting, I can confirm that the following has been undertaken as delegated:

- The Grounds Person has been notified that the Lawn Mower replacement request was approved, and the mower is on order
- The Grounds Person has been notified that the request for an external tap at the Harbour Road Toilets was approved, the chosen contractor notified and we are waiting for a confirmed date of installation.
- The Chosen contractor for the Memorial Headstone Safety Testing has been notified their quote was approved and we are waiting for a confirmed date for the works to take place.
- Summer activities have been organised utilising the funding by SALC for Health & Wellbeing. Inspired Schools, who provided activities in October half term last year, are doing the same during the summer holidays on four Mondays: 3<sup>rd</sup>, 10<sup>th</sup>, 17<sup>th</sup> & 24<sup>th</sup> August. These sessions will be based at Watchet Community Centre / MUGA from 9am – 3pm for children aged 4-11 who have started school.
- The previous Town Clerk had arranged with Albert Hockin of Good Habits Skateboard Coaching to run 6 skateboard sessions for 2 hours each at the new Wheeled Park at Henry Davey. He has already delivered 1 session over Easter and 1 in the May half term. Further dates are: 27<sup>th</sup> July, 3<sup>rd</sup>, 12<sup>th</sup> & 19<sup>th</sup> August (weather permitting). He will advertise and deal with bookings and we can share on our socials/noticeboards.
